We would like to inform you of our Positive Behavior Support (PBS) Reward Celebration happening in January and February. Beginning today, all Briggs Middle School students will be eligible for the Friendship Social scheduled for Friday February 10, 2012.

The PBS Team with the Briggs staff has continued working this school year to teach and model for our student's **responsible, respectful and safe behavior**. Most students have been doing a great job and we would like to have a reward party!

Students who do not receive a Level II or Level III referral from Tuesday January 10, 2012 through Friday February 10, 2012 will be eligible for the Friendship Social. Those students unable to follow these guidelines will be ineligible and will remain in school to attend class. *Administration does have flexibility to allow a student to attend if behavior has improved after the infraction has occurred.*
